- Epitaxial reactor operation experience.
- Knowledge of manufacturing processes, equipment utilization in their area of responsibility, Statistical Process Control techniques and computer literacy.

What You'll Be Doing

- Performs pre-production preparation that includes determining next order to be processed and its specifications using Factory Works software.
- Sets up equipment following the instructions on the traveler or in Factory Works.
- Interprets equipment operational status prior to running equipment. Closely monitors and adjusts equipment parameters as necessary to maintain the defined specifications. On non-automated machines, it is necessary to use extensive skills.
- Wipe down machines. This may involve dismantling and removal of parts. Reassembles parts and is also responsible for measuring wear with precision instruments or by visual inspection.
- Maintains effective housekeeping and cleanliness throughout all assigned work areas and stations to established 5S standards.
- Must complete all company certifications/qualifications and on the job training programs as required and approved by operations management.

- Look up product specifications using Spec Viewer, an application used to track material throughout the manufacturing process.
- Operates equipment following a wide range of process and equipment specifications to produce epitaxial wafers with varied range of specified requirements.
- Records all defined information (i.e. times, downtimes, temperatures, power, part lifetimes, flows, etc.) in MMS, cell controller and check sheets. Records information on Statistical Process Control charts, interprets results, and makes recommendations for corrective action if warranted.
- Employees are also expected to fully participate in safety activities, drills and meetings as directed by supervision.
- May perform other duties as assigned.
